Transitions and Changes

Life involves a series of frequent changes. Some are welcomed; others uninvited and unwanted. Even positive changes can be difficult and letting go of the familiar can be uncomfortable. *Change* indicates something different in our situation and environment and at Maple Grove we have been, and will continue to experience changes...much more than we're accustomed to! *Transition*, however, refers to our psychological response to change. As we transition we undergo a process of inner-reorientation and meaning-redefinition to incorporate change.

Transition researchers from the University of Kentucky state that "When we refuse to accept a transition, when the fear of what lies ahead prevents us from moving forward, we appear to stand still on life's busy road while life speeds past." And as we "refuse to accept a transition" our stress and anxiety build. Recognizing, acknowledging and processing change in our lives enable us to begin to move faithfully and freely through change.

Stephen Ministers are trained to listen reflectively and confidentially to their care receivers and a dedicated listener enables us to process change. Community Ministry Minute

Our Local Outreach Grants support over 70 ministries and provide seed money in helping new outreach ministries get started. We provide site visits and consultation for all of these ministries through our Local Outreach Support Team. 80% of the money received through UM Community Ministries Apportionments goes back to local churches as they reach out to their communities. Over 20,000 persons living in poverty are served each month.

Each year we have a theme that guides our work: In 2007 our theme was; Celebrating Local Outreach Across Nine Counties. In 2008 it was Passion, Gifts and Partnerships. In 2009 our theme was Expanding Community Circles of Hope and in 2010 it was Building Bridges out of Poverty (as part of Ministry with the poor emphasis our conference).

Our theme for 2011 is: Fanning the Flame by Going Deeper, stressing the need for all of us to grow as disciples of Jesus. Our goal is that every person becomes a disciple of Jesus who uses their strengths and assets to make visible the Kingdom of God in their local communities.

Maple Grove youth will go to South Carolina for their week-long mission trip June 18-25. We will be working with an organization called Rural Mission to improve the homes of local residents. The families we will serve are African-American descendants of slaves. Their Gullah culture has developed over generations on the isolated, rural Sea Islands. In addition to the housing repair work we will do, we plan to visit historic Charleston and Fort Sumter, explore the barrier islands, and enjoy the food and music at the community's traditional Seafood Jamboree. We hope to learn much and develop a deeper appreciation for our Sea Island brothers and sisters in Christ and their ecologically-important coastal environment.
